## GENERAL INFORMATION

Manitoba is adopting a phased approach to begin restoring services. Manitobans are reminded that the current situation is mutable, and some measures may need to be reintroduced or new restrictions implemented to reduce any further spread of the virus.

## PHASE ONE - BEGINNING MAY 4TH

- non-urgent surgery and diagnostic procedures restored
- therapeutic and health care services restored
- retail businesses reopen\*
- restaurants patio/walk-up services restored\*
- hairstylists and barbers reopen\*
- museums, galleries and libraries reopen\*
- outdoor recreation and campgrounds reopen\*



Public Health measures such as social distancing and frequent sanitation remain. Travel restrictions remain, including mandatory self-isolation of 14 days upon return to Manitoba. Schools will remain closed. Gatherings remain limited to 10 people.

## PHASE TWO - BEGINNING NO EARLIER THAN JUNE 1ST\*\*

- expanding public gatherings
- restaurants - dine-in services restored
- film production reopened
- non-contact children's sports restored



Public Health measures such as social distancing and frequent sanitation remain. Travel restrictions remain, including mandatory self-isolation of 14 days upon return to Manitoba.

\*\*Phase two will be entirely dependent on the data obtained from phase one. If results during or at the end of phase one are not positive, the province will not proceed with further easing of public health measures and may reintroduce others.

## FUTURE PHASES

If phase two is successful, new phases will be implemented on a three-to-four week basis. The following services are being considered for future phases;

- performing arts venues reopen
- other non-essential businesses reopen
- large gatherings / events reopen
